Biography

Full name: Samuil Davidovic Ščupak; pseudonym: Vladimirov; born in Taganrog, Russia 1880, died in Germany c. 1943; member of the `Bund' and a Menshevik; lived in exile in Paris with his wife Nadezda E. Stejnberg from 1907; returned to Russia in 1917 to emigrate again in 1919; during the Second World War deported to Germany.
