History

French Student movement: after a temporary unity during the 1968 May revolt, the French student movement was split by many ideological conflicts in the 1970s; next to existing organizations many small radical left-wing organizations were established; only government plans for educational and university reforms temporarily reunited the students. Michel Renard: born in 1954 in Paris; history teacher; together with Julien Dray (on behalf of the Ligue Communiste Révolutionnaire) and Jean-Christophe Cambadélis (on behalf of the Alliance des Jeunes pour le Socialisme of the Parti Communiste Internationale) Michel Renard (on behalf of the Union Nationale des Étudiants de France-Renouveau) participated in leading the movement against the university reforms of the French government in 1976; also active in the election campaign of Pierre Juquin in 1988.

INTRODUCTION

History

After a temporary unity during the May revolt of 1968, the French student movement was split by many ideological conflicts in the 1970's. Next to existing organizations many (tiny) radical organizations (communist, anti-communist and trotskyist) were established. Only government plans for educational and university reforms reunited the students during a short period.

Michel Renard, born in Paris 1954, participated (on behalf of the Union Nationale des Étudiants de France-Renouveau) together with Julien Dray (on behalf of the Ligue Communiste Révolutionnaire) and Jean-Christophe Cambadélis (on behalf of the Alliance des Jeunes pour le Socialisme of the Parti Communiste Internationale) in leading the movement against the university reforms of the French government in 1976. He became history teacher and was also active in the election campaign for presidency of Pierre Juquin in 1988.

The collection

The collection French Student Movement, mainly collected by Michel Renard, arrived at the IISH in 1995. Posters have been transferred to the audio-visual department of the IISH and some periodicals and brochures to the library of the IISH.

The collection has a size of 0.65 metres.
