

## Wladavostokburo of Komintern.



For the movement in Japan, Korea and China a Far Eastern buro of Komintern has been established, existinf out of three members Sen Katayam, H. Maring and G. Voitinsky.

The buro is based on the principle, that for the direction of the work in the Far East it is necessary to come nearer to the countries

mentioned above.

The task of the buro is:

I.To give advices to the comm.parties and the labourunions of the three countries.

II To give information on the situation of the movement and generally on the political and economical situation in these countries to IKKI.

IIITo prepare the decisions of IKKI before important political events in these countries take place.

IV To give direction in the publication work and in political campaign V.To establish close connections between the Japanese and Chinese movements.

VI. To bring revolutionary labouranions under the banner of Profintern. VII The control of the youth and womenmovements in these countries.
